- The Special Education Team has decided to implement their own Artful Learning Program into their curriculum with the Mild/Moderate & Severe needs kids.
- Last year they taught about "Perseverance" and how it tied into their Masterwork which was The Great Wall of China. Inquiry Center & Original work all tied into "Perseverance".
